Stand by call for cardiac arrest taken at 10.00. Pt arrived at 10.15am. Had knee replacement 4/7 ago at Wrightington Hospital. Pt asystole on arrival. Pt collapsed at 09.00 ambulance arrived at Wrightington at 09.30 and was intubated by paramedics. CPR was continued. Paramedics state pt was in asystole on their arrival and continued to be asystolic until their departure at 10.00. So therefore pt asystolic for 45 minutes. before arriving in ECC. I spoke to Dr Wilkins at Wrightington hospital when I asked why pt was transferred after such a prolonged arrest in asystole he stated when he rang his consultant he was advised to send pt to Wison for specialist care and for the relatives benefit. I advised me pt was not in asystole but PEA with HR of 44.
